OSAP (Ontario Student Assistance Program)

The BScPA Program is recognized by OSAP. Students enrolled in the BScPA program may qualify for a fee deferral from the Student Accounts office, if the student is awaiting OSAP support.

The fee for the program for the first year of the program is approximately \$12,350. The compulsory non-academic fees will be approximately \$1500.
